NOTICE AND AGENDA OF REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING

Notice is hereby given that the City Council of San Elizario, Texas will hold a Regular Meeting on **Tuesday, March 27, 2018 6:00pm., at San Elizario City Hall, 12710 Church St., San Elizario, Texas** at which time the following items will be discussed, to wit:

1. Roll Call

- c. Excuse absent Council members.

2. Public Comment

The City Council welcomes public comments to topics not listed on the agenda. This segment is limited to thirty (30) minutes to the first ten (10) speakers. Speakers must sign in to speak before the start of the council meeting and shall limit their comments to three (3) minutes. The City Council cannot respond to matters not listed on the agenda until placed on a future agenda.

3. Consent Agenda

All matters listed under the Consent Agenda will be considered by the City Council to be routine and will be enacted by one motion. There will be no separate discussion on these items unless City Council members remove specific items from the Consent Agenda to the Regular Agenda for discussion prior to voting on adoption of the Consent Agenda. Removed items will be considered and acted on after a vote on the Consent Agenda.

4. Discussion and Action: Ordinance adopting Amendment No. 1 to the Fiscal Year 2017-2018 budget to add the following line items and amounts: Revenue: Farm Lease/Rental Revenue, \$14,113.65: and Expense: Farm Irrigation, \$11,123.55.


