**2. Public Comment**

The City Council cannot respond to matters not listed on the agenda until placed on a future agenda.

All matters listed under the Consent Agenda will be considered by the City Council to be routine and will be enacted by one motion. There will be no separate discussion on these items unless City Council members remove specific items from the Consent Agenda to the Regular Agenda for discussion prior to voting on adoption of the Consent Agenda. Removed items will be considered and acted on after a vote on the Consent Agenda.

**4. Discussion and Action:** An ordinance amending Ordinance No. 1515.26, the Manufactured Housing Ordinance to clarify the definitions regarding travel and/or camping trailers and to impose water and sewer installation requirements, and to declare that a violation of the ordinance is a misdemeanor offense punishable by a fine not to exceed either \$500 or \$2000, as provided in Section 4.02 of the Ordinance.

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certain activities and conduct; authorizing signage; and authorizing a permitting and appeal process as appropriate for the parks.


