ORDINANCE NO. 1703.09

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE CERTIFIED APPRAISAL TAX ROLL SUBMITTED BY THE EL PASO COUNTY APPRAISAL DISTRICT FOR THE CITY OF SAN ELIZARIO FOR FY 2017-18

WHEREAS, the El Paso County Tax Appraisal District has prepared, certified and submitted the appraisal roll of taxable property for the City of San Elizario ("City") for Fiscal Year ("FY") 2017-2018; and

conflict, and the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and remain controlling as to the matters regulated, herein.


